- Cement Top on the production casing did cover 200' above the geologist's pick for the Mesa Verde top (2,495')
- Cement Top did cover the geologist's pick for the top of gas (3,801')
- Cement top did cover all the zones that we had an interest in completing. Top perforation is 4,030'
- Observed bradenhead pressure was at 355 psi as of 8:15 this morning

WPX requests permission to run a hard line to a tank to vent the bradenhead pressure for 90 days. In the meantime, remediation procedures will be generated in case at the end of the 90 days additional action is required.
