

Waste Management Plan

Winder 9-31, 32, 41, 42 Sec 9 T6N R67W Weld County

Operator shall ensure the E&P waste is properly stored, handled, transported, and treated, recycled, or disposed to prevent significant environmental impacts to air, water, soil, or biological resources.

This plan shall include the following;

Produced Water:

1. All produced water will be transported to a permitted Class II injection well and injected.

Drilling Fluids:

1. Well will be drilled closed loop therefore drilling mud will be recycled to the next location.
2. Mud system will be water-based bentonitic fluids and any excess mud will be disposed of per Rule 907 d.(3) B.
3. Drill Cuttings removed from the mud system will either be dried and used on site for berm and road material or disposed of per Rule 907 d.(3) B.

Oily Waste:

1. All oily waste as defined in Rule 907 e. will be disposed of at a commercial solid waste disposal facility.

Other E&P Waste:

1. All other waste such as workover fluids, tank bottoms, and well fluids in flowlines will be injected into a permitted Class II well.
