I am reviewing the Form 2A oil and gas location assessment for the Varra Tank Battery (Doc #400324599). I have the following changes:

1. Water Resources: The location is in a sensitive area due to the presence of shallow ground water, and its proximity to the Eaton Canal. It appears there is a culvert that provides drainage from the field where the tank battery is proposed, under the county road into the Eaton Canal. Do you have any details regarding how the proposed tank battery will be constructed to minimize the risk of a spill on the location from draining through this culvert into the Eaton Canal?
2. LGD Comments: The Town of Windsor has commented on this Form 2A.
