## NOTICE OF HEARING Before the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado.

Case No. 13.

In the matter of the application of Sinclair Oil & Gas Company for an order from the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission providing for Twenty Acre (more or less) drilling and spacing units for the first sand or "D" sand common source of supply underlying the S½ of section 19 and N½ of section 30, all in township 7 North, Range 54 west, Logan county, Colorado.

To all operators, purchasers and takers of oil and gas in Colorado and all other interested persons, particularly in Logan county, Colorado:

Notice is hereby given that the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission will hold a hearing at Room 704, State Capitol Annex, 14th Avenue and Sherman Street, Denver, Colorado, on the 25th day of November 1952, at 10 a.m., upon the application of Sinclair Oil & Gas Company for an order establishing proper drilling and spacing units for the production of oil and gas from the First Sand or "D" Sand common source of supply underlying the South Half (S½) of Section 19 and North Half (N½) of Section 30, all in Township 7 North, Range 54 West, Logan County, Colorado.

Notice is further given that applicant requests that the Commission establish twenty acres (more or less) drilling and spacing units for said common source of supply with wells to be located in the center of the northeast and southwest ten acres of each quarter quarter section and each quarter quarter section to be divided into two drilling and spacing units by a line running east and west through the approximate center thereof, and further that a tolerance of fifty feet in any direction from the prescribed well location be provided in the event surface obstructions or undue hazards are encountered at the prescribed well location.

Notice is further given that this Commission will at said time and place fix the location of the permitted well in each drilling and spacing unit and take such other action as is necessary to protect the correlative rights of all interested parties and to prevent waste in the production of oil and gas from said common source of supply that to the Commission seems proper.

All persons interested in this matter may appear on said date and be heard.
