

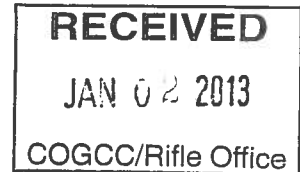


Jay,

Thank you for your timely approval on these wells. With the wells being deferred, the request to complete slipped my mind until looking at my "to do prior to completions" check list.

We are starting on the lower stages of the KP 11-17 today and I wanted to touch base with you regarding your comment on adjusting upwards the top perf at 5860'. This condition eliminated two stages (original proposed top perf was 5584'). Would you consider allowing one more stage with proposed top perf at 5833"? We should be at this stage early next week and would like to give our wireline and frac crews enough time to prepare if possible.
