Dear Mrs. Kintz:

It was a pleasure speaking with you last week. As you know, we are planning to start a drilling program on your land in a few weeks. We discussed what reasonable compensation for surface damages would be for crop loss on the land around the farm house resulting from this well and future wells. We agreed that \$2,500.00 should cover the loss of crops. This amount will also compensate you for the use of the lands upon which we will place our access roads, underground pipelines, tanks, completion and production equipment and well heads during the term of our lease. Obviously, if unusual residual damage is caused by our operations, we will re-visit our discussions. The lands covered by this agreement will be:
