Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (COGCC) staff has reviewed the Remediation Work Plan Form 27 for the Partially Buried Tank closure and the Notice of Completion (Form 04) submitted by XTO on October 19, 2012, and January 02, 2013 respectively, for the referenced site. Based on review of data presented, it appears that no further action is necessary at this time at this site. However, should future conditions at the site be discovered of contaminant concentrations in soils exceeding COGCC standards or if groundwater is found to be significantly impacted, COGCC may require that further investigation and/or remediation be conducted.
