I regularly check my emails back to see what's pending, what has been left behind. I found these two spills that occurred in 2011 and that have not been closed as of today. I would appreciate your help so that I can close these projects.

1. COGCC Tracking # 2524411, Submitted closure documents on 11/22/11. The spill date is 02/19/11 at PCU F23-18G.

I was apparently not copied in that closure documents submittal because I can't find anything in my emails and I don't have any closure document on file. Would you be kind enough and send me the closure documents so that I can close the Form 19 tracking # 2524411?

2. Submitted closure documents on 11/1/11. Spill dated 06/20/11 at PCU T68X-11G. No Tracking number

The PCU 68-11 injection line failed near the PCU 35-11 pad. Injection line origin is the PCU T68X-11G pad. I have the form 19 and the pit closure report (by KRW Consulting). Chris Canfield requested that a Non-Facility ID was created but this never happened (and therefore Form 19 was not entered). I checked the coordinates provided for the spill location and it seems to me that they were wrong (see attached email by Lisa Andrews and the slide I prepared). Would you please check the coordinates? Once we clarify that, I will create the Facility ID, enter the Form 19, and then close the project.
