Ladies and Gentlemen:

The Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission ("COGCC") has adopted guidelines and procedures regarding oil and gas activities affecting the surface. These rules stipulate that an affected surface owner must be given advance notice in writing by an operator at least thirty (30) days prior to drilling an oil and gas well.

Kerr-McGee Oil and Gas Onshore LP ("KMG") intends to begin operations to drill the above captioned oil and gas well(s) upon approval of title, receipt of permits from the COGCC prior to November 30, 2013. As the surface owner, it is your responsibility to notify the tenant farmer, if applicable, of this proposed operation.

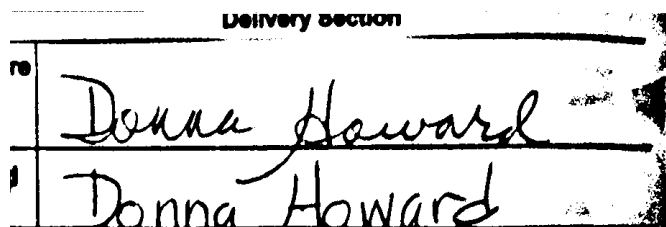

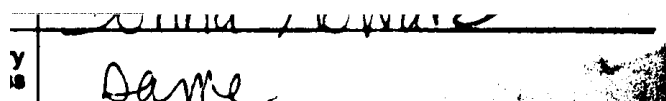
