All released oil was contained within the lined-steel, secondary containment.	

**CORRECTIVE ACTION**

Describe immediate response (how stopped, contained and recovered):  
Upon discovery, the valve was immediately closed on the tank manifold. All released oil was recovered with a vacuum truck and transported offsite for recycling at Bill Barrett Corporation's (BBC) centralized water facility. The lined containment will be flushed in the coming days with hot water and detergent to remove any residual hydrocarbons. A topographic site location map is provided as Figure 1.

Describe any emergency pits constructed: NA

How was the extent of contamination determined?  
Released oil was fully contained within the tank battery's lined secondary containment. No evidence of a compromised liner was observed during oil recovery.

Further remediation activities proposed (attach separate sheet if needed):  
As the entire volume of released oil was recovered and the containment will soon be flushed to remove any residual hydrocarbons, BBC is requesting a No Further Action determination for this release.

Describe measures taken to prevent problem from reoccurring: Reviewed the loading and site inspection procedures prior to truck loading activities with contractors.



