When can I expect the 2A to amend location 416234? In addition, the comments don't quite make sense...why would the Shable HNL wells be moved via Sundry onto the location? They already exist on the location. It would really help to see the plan for this section, and section 10 if involved as well.

Regarding the Shable AB 11 Econode: The water well listed to be 630 feet from the location appears be an abandoned monitoring well. The next nearest registered water well appears to be 159087 located approximately 7300 feet southeast of the location. Please confirm the distance to the nearest water well.

I listened to your voice mail and based on what I heard, I recommend we do the following:

1. Use Form 2A 400336371 to amend Location ID 431056 SHABLE USX AB 11-65-1HNL TANK since I understand that Location ID 431056 SHABLE USX AB 11-65-1HNL TANK will not be constructed. This will move the proposed location to the Shable AB 11 Econode.
2. Please confirm whether the existing tank battery SHABLE USX AB11-11P, 12P, 14P will remain as located, or if these wells will also produce to the SHABLE AB 11 ECONODE.

3. If the existing tank battery will remain, please submit a Sundry Notice to add it to Location ID 416234 SHABLE USX AB 11-65-1HNL.

In the meantime, I'll continue my review of the Shable AB 11 Econode and let you know if further changes to that document are necessary.
