Jeff,

You should have received a field inspection from me. You probably got one from Kym also addressing other things besides the environmental issues. I tried to address the current release and the skim pit separately, but the inspection forms aren't always clear. Please continue with the cleanup of the current spill (including the material at the wellhead) and submit a Form 19 within 10-days to document the cleanup. If you haul the oily waste off location to a landfill I'll need copies of the disposal documentation. If you want to try land treatment on site, you could stockpile the material on plastic and berm it until you come up with a plan for the skim pit and associated waste.

Regarding the skim pit closure or upgrade, I tried to give extra time until the end of May to deal with that. It will require submittal of a Form 27 for prior approval and it should address all of the oily waste site wide at that time including the material from the skim pit, surrounding the produced water pit, tank battery and anything stockpiled from the current spill.
