Dear Director:

Great Western Oil and Gas Company, LLC is planning to drill the above mentioned wells to the Niobrara-Codell formations.

The surface location of Great Western's proposed wells has been staked outside of the 318A.a drilling window. The location is being permitted and as an exception location. This location is a good location to both reduce the impact on the surface owner and to increase the number of wells reachable from one well pad to minimize surface disturbance.

Rule 318Ac(2) of the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (COGCC) Rules and Regulations requiring the wells drilled greater than 50 feet from a well unless safety or mechanical consideration of the well to be twinned or topographical or surface constrains justify a location greater than 50 feet the operator shall provide consent to the exception signed by the surface owner on which the well is proposed to be located in order for the Director to approve the well location. Please find the attached signed location 318Ac(2) waiver.
