NOTICE OF HEARING

TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS AND TO
WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

As a result of a hearing held November 21 and 22, 1983 in the Old Supreme Court Chambers, State Capitol Building, after giving Notice of Hearing, the Commission established 80-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of oil and/or gas from the Codell formation underlying certain lands in Adams, Boulder, Jefferson, Larimer and Weld Counties, Colorado. In addition the Commission ordered that there would be no flaring of gas from wells that have a gas/oil ratio of 500:1 or more, and further that those wells that would be allowed to flare would be restricted to no more than 25 MCF/day.

It has come to the attention of the Commission that there may be stripper wells or wells with such low capacity as to not warrant the installation of a gas gathering line. The Commission, therefore, has suspended this portion of the order until December 19, 1983 at which time operators may present to the Commission requests for exception or modification, based on factual data, relating to this matter.
