Based on the Soil Analytical Results, the Soil Sample Location Figure, and soil and fluid disposal information that Magpie Operating has submitted, coupled with the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission Staff field inspection conducted February 7 and documented by inspection number 667500126, COGCC will not require further remediation action at this time and approves the pit closure for Pit ID 431159 at the Little Beaver Unit 41 well location (API 05-121-06222/Location ID 316988).

This No Further Action notice does not preclude COGCC from requiring further site investigation or remediation at the site if impacts to soil or ground water in excess of the concentrations in Table 910-1 are discovered at the site in the future.

In order to close the Notice of Alleged Violation 200358023 issued to Magpie Operating on August 1, 2012, a company representative must sign the section on the attached NOAV "TO BE COMPLETED BY OPERATOR - When alleged violation is correction, sign this notice and return to above address;".
