On July 14, 1954, the Commis-  
sion issued Order No. 34-1  
which established 640-acre drill-  
ing and spacing units for the  
production of gas from the To-  
peka-Lansing formation under-  
lying lands in the Greenwood  
Field. By subsequent orders,  
certain lands were added and  
deleted from the spaced area.

On September 10, 1979, Rincon  
Operating Company, by its at-  
torneys, filed with the Commis-  
sion an application for an or-  
der pooling all tracts of land  
within the designated unit con-  
sisting of Section 30, Township  
31 South, Range 41 West, 6th P.  
M., Baca County, Colorado for  
the development of the Topeka-  
Lansing formation underlying  
said unit.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN,  
that the Oil and Gas Conserva-
