

The Commission has previously issued its Order No. 36-1, dated June 3, 1954, which, among other things, defines the Gary Field. Subsequent development of this area indicates that the following lands should be deleted from said field:  
Township 1 North, Range 56 West, 6th P. M.  
Section 9: All Section 20: All  
Section 10: All Section 21: S $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 15: N $\frac{1}{4}$ , SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 28: W $\frac{1}{2}$   
Section 16: N $\frac{1}{2}$ , SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 29: All

All operators and owners of working interests, and all persons interested in the above area, are hereby requested to appear at the hearing set forth above, and to show cause, if any they have, why the Commission should not enter an order deleting all or portions of the above described lands from the Gary Field, Morgan County, Colorado.

Pursuant to said hearing in the above entitled matter, at the time and place aforesaid, or at any adjourned meeting, the Commission will enter such orders as it deems appropriate to prevent the waste of oil and gas, either or both, in the operation of said field, and to carry out the purposes of the statute.
