condemned is nonproductive of
oil and gas in commercial quan-
tities under either primary or
secondary recovery methods; and
all other pertinent data related
thereto which should include,
among other things, details of
injection and withdrawal plans
and systems; related tempera-
ture, pressure, and gas volume
data; physical and chemical
characteristics of gas to be
stored; the necessity of the project;
and all protective measures
against any type of danger or
adverse effect connected with
