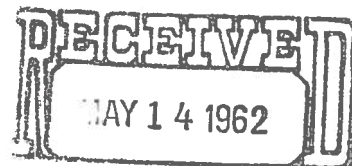

NOTICE OF HEARING

TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

On May 7, 1962, the Monsanto Chemical Company filed with the Commission an application for an order designating the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 13 and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 14, Township 1 North, Range 58 West, 6th P. M., as part of the common source of supply of gas in the "D" sand of the Adena Field; that this area be designated as a drilling unit for the production of gas from the "D" sand thereunder; that said unit be given an allowable of 600,000 cubic feet of gas per day; and that the permitted well for this area for the production of gas from the "D" sand be designated as the Monsanto No. 3 B. F. Crone well located in the southeast corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 13; and that the Commission issue such other orders and regulations as it may deem necessary.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that The Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado, pursuant to said application, has set the upon entitled matter for hearing on:

Pursuant to said hearing in the above entitled matter, at the time and place aforesaid, or at any adjourned meeting, the Commission will enter such orders as it deems appropriate to prevent the waste of oil and gas, either or both, in the operation of said field, with particular reference to rules regulating the spacing of wells, and practices relating to the drilling and completion of wells in said field.
