The Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado has called a hearing to consider the petition of the Shell Oil Company for an order providing for forty-acre drilling and spacing units according to the Governmental survey thereof for the "D" Sand, common source of supply, and the "J" Sand, common source of supply, underlying the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of section 23, the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of section 26, all of sections 24 and 25 in Township 5 North, Range 61 West, Weld County, Colorado, and the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of section 19 and the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of section 30, Township 5 North, Range 60 West, Morgan County, Colorado, which area is presently referred to as the Masters Field.
