The closes water well (Receipt No. 9087716) is approximately 1,315' from the location. The closest water well with depth to groundwater information is approximately 11,440' (Receipt No. 0436303) from the location. The location was marked as sensitive due to the depth to groundwater. An Alternate Production Facility Layout has been included so the COGCC can evaluate the alternate production facility location at the same time they review the anticipated production facility location. The drawing was generated to allow flexibility on placement of the production facilities for both Aurora Power and the surface owner.
