Good afternoon Fred,

Listed below are CPWs recommended BMPs for the proposed PetroShare Corp's Voloshin 3-25 location.

Wildlife concerns: The proposed pad location is within an Elk Winter Concentration Area. Based on the above wildlife concerns, CPW recommends the following best management practices (BMPs):

1. Where oil and gas activities must occur in Elk Winter Concentration Areas, conduct these activities outside the time period from December 1 through April 15.

2. Restrict post-development well site visitations to between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. from December 1 to April 15, to accommodate Elk Winter Concentration Areas.
3. Establish company guidelines to minimize wildlife mortality from vehicle collisions on roads. Slow speeds and increased awareness among employees and contractors traveling to and from the site should help to reduce impacts.
4. Install and utilize bear-proof dumpsters and trash receptacles for all food-related trash on location, following COGCC Rule 1204 a-1.

CPW would appreciate your concurrence with the proposed BMPs. CPW comments are due Tuesday May 14th, 2013. Please let me know if you have questions, or would like to discuss any of these items.
