

MEMORANDUM OF SURFACE DAMAGE AND RELEASE AGREEMENT

This Memorandum of Surface Damage and Release Agreement is executed by Larry D. 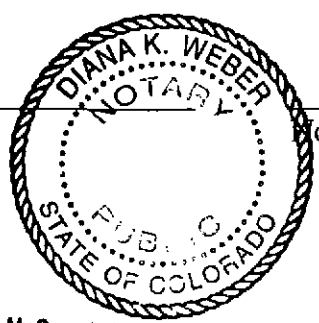
