In response to your May 31, 2013 request for information concerning the recent construction activity around the Ross G#1 location, I am submitting the following information:

- Memorandum regarding the 400 lateral of the Platte Valley System
- MSDS for non-odorized natural gas
- MSDS for Unichem 7125 chemical product

From our perspective, the key point to note is the lack of any free liquid either observed or captured during the line de-pressurization process associated with this work. Your request also sought a list of any chemicals associated with this pipeline segment. I have included the MSDS for the Unichem 7125 chemical which is routinely injected into the pipeline for maintenance purposes at the rate of approximately 2 gallons per day. Again I would mention none of this or any other liquid product was released during this work process.

Please let me know if you need anything further from Kerr-McGee Gathering on this matter.
