This has been logged in as COGCC Spill #200381625. Please provide a Form 27 that delineates the extent of impact, to include analytical sampling of the spill tested for Table 910-1 parameters. Once the extent of impact is defined, an appropriate remediation program needs to be submitted in accordance with COGCC Rules 909 and 910.

I would suggest the use of a professional environmental consulting group to collect data and assess impacts due to the sensitive nature of spills in this area. Full assessment and remediation is required.
