John,

As discussed via phone, LTE and Beren Corporation have moved the area previously proposed for land treatment of the impacted soil at the Wright facility. The two prior locations were proposed due to the initial soil volume at the site. Now that Beren has disposed of all but approximately 30 cubic yards of impacted soil at a licensed disposal facility, a smaller area can be used to land treat the remaining soil. The initial areas were also stormwater pooling areas, which do not make good land treatment areas.

There is a sufficient area of flat land to the east of the tank battery that Beren contractors will conduct land treatment of the onsite impacted soil as per the approved waste management plan. This plot of land is within the current, fenced lease boundary.
