Description of Well Site and Construction Area

1-4 acre site with access road for drilling of oil and gas well. Terrain is flat with native grass and sagebrush. A shallow surface water depression, which is dry, is located approximately 475' Southeast of the well pad. A dirt brim will be installed on the East and South side of the well pad to protect this surface water area. Surface Roughening will be used on low side of drill site to reduce speed of runoff, increase infiltration, reduce erosion, trap sediment and prepare soil for reseeding. Drilling pits closed and reclaimed within 3 months weather permitting. Topsoil will be separated and spread on drill site as final operation before reseeding operations which will be completed within 6 months weather permitting. To prevent soil erosion site will be disked and straw crimped in or manure spread.
