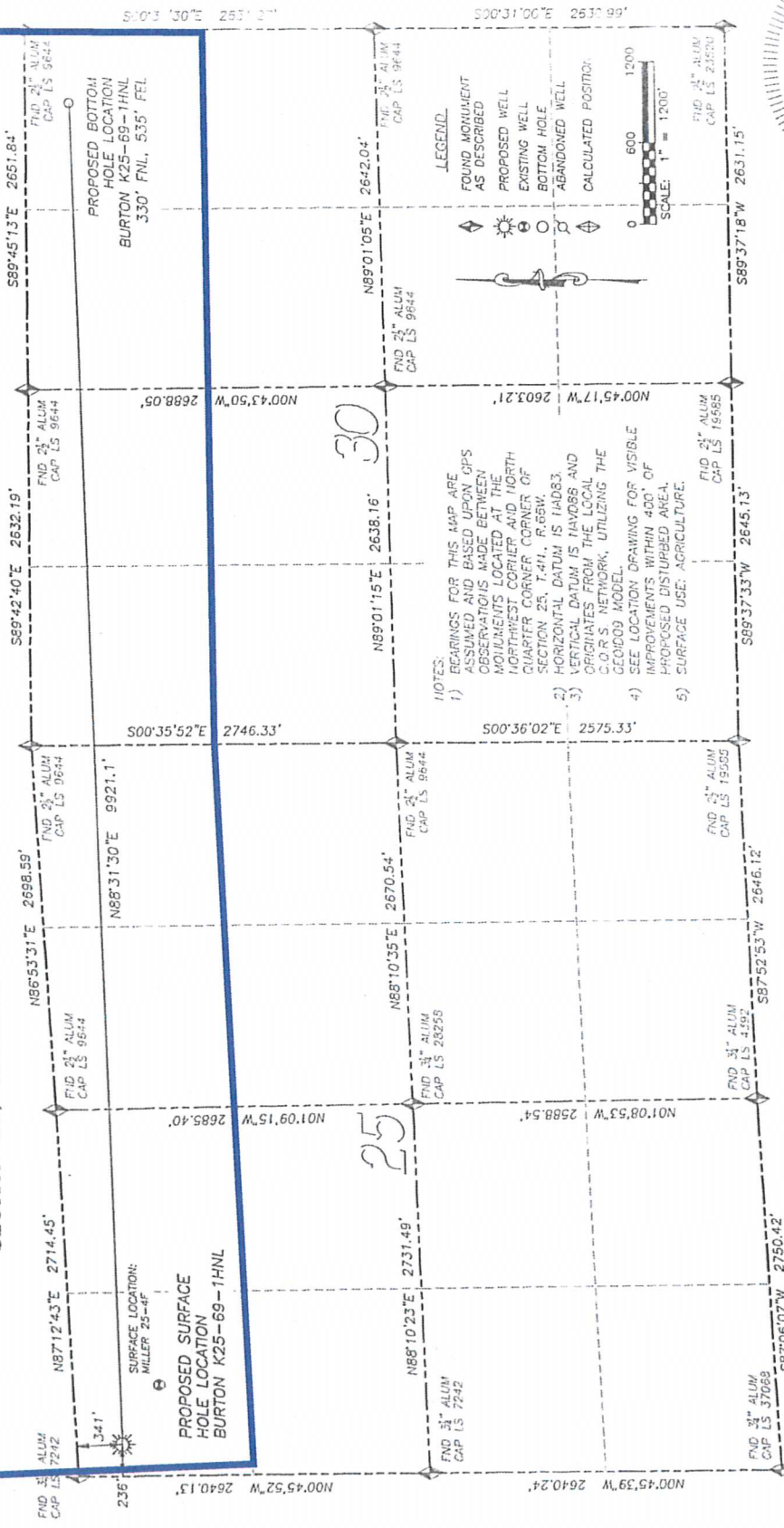


Proposed 655.02± acre spacing unit
