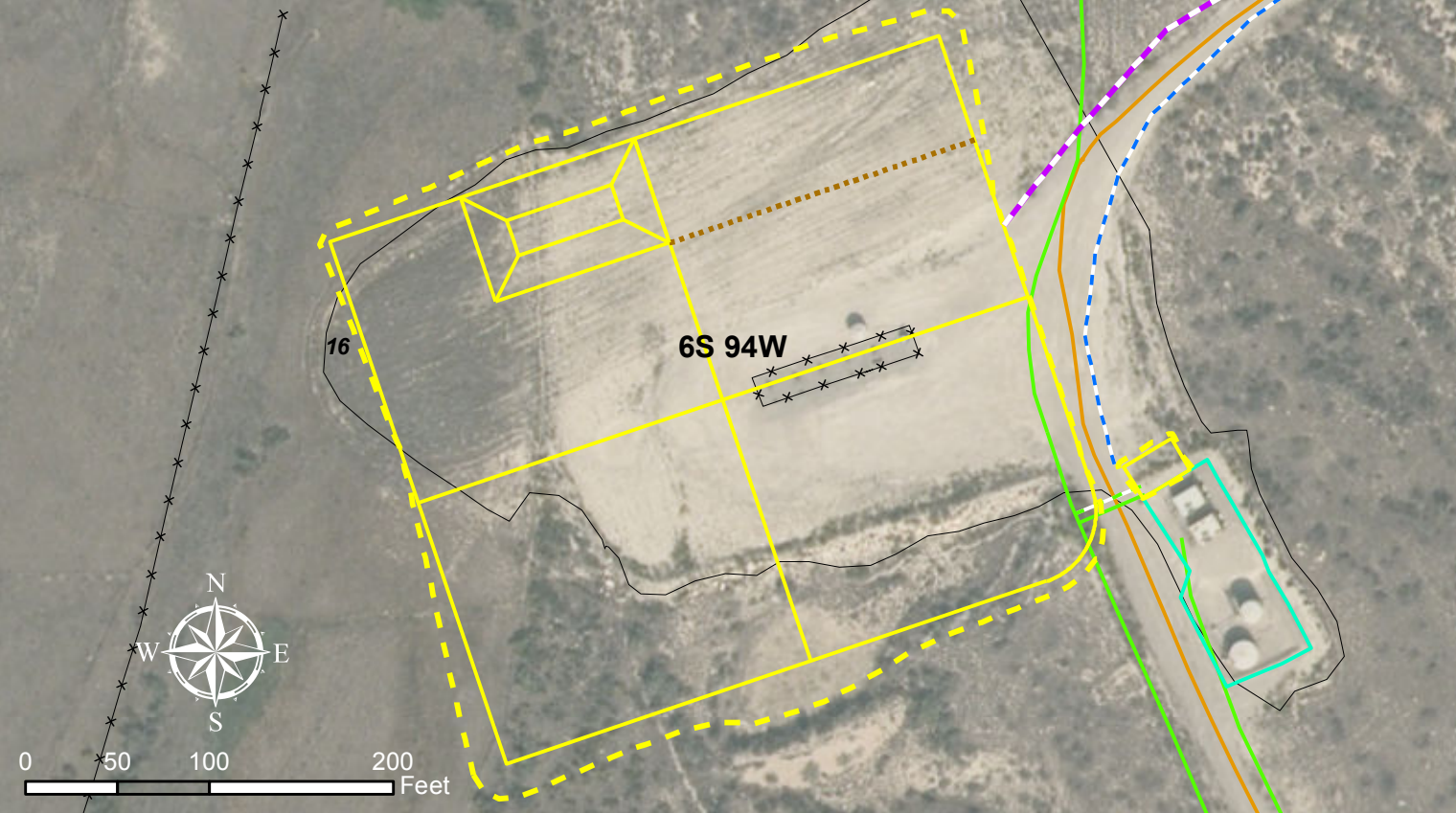
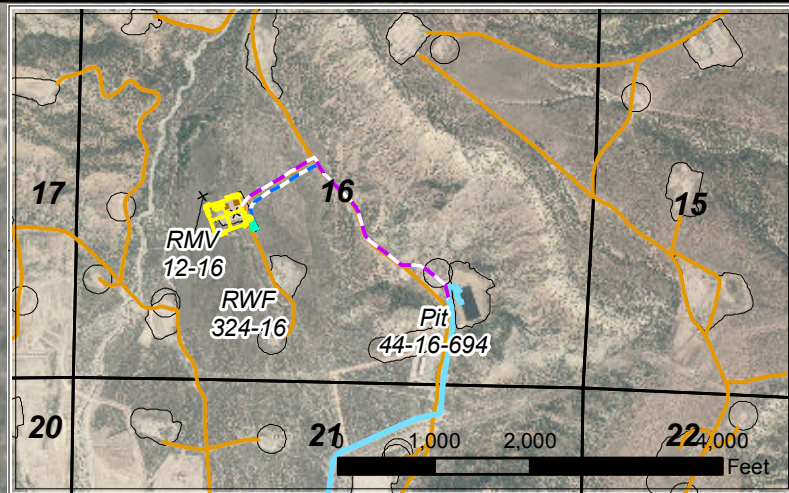


Geologist Information

Plan of Development

Access: Use existing access
 Drilling: Efficiency Rig
 Cuttings: Cuttings will be stored on the northern side of the pad in a cuttings management area. A small cement trench will be along the north side as well.
 SIMOPS: No
 Completions: Frac on pad and run 2-10" surface water supply lines from the existing Clough 104 water pit (Pit 44 16-694).
 Flowback: On pad
 Production: Production equipment will stay where it is currently located but an additional 20'x30' space will be needed on the northern side of the units for an additional separator. Water will be piped through a new water line to the existing infrastructure in the main road. Condensate will stay on pad.
 Pipeline: A new 6" gas line will run across the road to existing 6" line. A new 4" water to follow access road tying into existing waterline in main road.
