Cynthia,

I have reviewed the referenced Form 2A Oil and Gas Location Assessment and have several comments.

1) Per COGCC Rule 303.b.(3)C, please provide me with a description of all oil, gas, and/or water pipelines planned for this oil and gas location and I will add it to the Other Facilities section of the Form 2A.

2) In the Construction section you have indicated the estimated date that interim reclamation will begin as 10/17/15. This is two years after the planned date that construction will commence (10/17/13). Per COGCC Rule 1003.b., interim reclamation shall occur no later than six months on non-cropland after drilling and completion operations. Please provide me with a revised estimated date that interim reclamation will begin and I will change it on the Form 2A.

3) In the Cultural Distance Information section you have indicated that the nearest Building is 2,522 feet. On your Location Drawing, that nearest building is listed as a house. Because houses are also Building Units, I will change the distance to the nearest Building Unit from 5,280 feet to 2,522 feet on the Form 2A.

4) In the Water Resources section you have indicated the oil and gas location is not in a Sensitive Area. This location is within the Upper Crow Creek Designated Groundwater Basin, which is by definition a Sensitive Area. Therefore, I will change the Sensitive Area designation on the Form 2A from NO to YES.

5) A review of the permit for the nearest water well (Permit #126281) indicates this water well has been abandoned. The next nearest water well is Permit #13963 located approximately 2,525 feet northeast of the oil and gas location. The depth to groundwater listed for this water well is 50 feet. Therefore I will change the distance to the nearest water well and estimated depth to groundwater in the Water Resources section of the Form 2A to reflect this water well.

6) In the Water Resources section, you should provide the basis for the depth to groundwater and sensitive area determination. This was left blank on the Form 2A. Using the information from my Comment 4 & 5 above, I will complete this part of the Form 2A for you this time.
