Gentlemen,

As promised, the following schedule to comply with corrective actions will be adhered to and is subject to your approval and amendments. As soon as the temporary restraining order (TRO) for the well site is removed, our field operation manager will commence the process of meeting the following deadlines for each stipulated action and will maintain a presence at the well site until requests have been completed. A meeting with the Hidden Springs Home Owner's Association is scheduled for October 9, 2013 to sign and agree to release the TRO. We project a release of the TRO from the Routt County court will take 2 to 3 business days. Randy Miller of North Park Engineering & Consulting, Inc., has agreed to provide his professional remediation services to assist Ephphatha, LLC in complying with the COGCC recommendations and guidelines for any additional removal of contaminated material. Mr. Miller has been requested to provide a work plan to comply with action item # 3 below, and we hope to have something in hand and dispersed to the COGCC by October 11, 2013. In addition to the work plan, the following items will be of utmost priority in rectifying upon release of the TRO:

- 1) Correct signage and labeling within 10 business days.
- 2) Removal of excess equipment/material within 10 business days.

- 3) Plan of execution by an environmental professional for the additional removal of any soil/plant/water contamination with specific details as to areas to be removed, plan for the proper disposal of any substances removed, and additional testing to ensure proper removal and compliance with the COGCC guidelines and recommendations was efficacious.
- 4) Inspection and maintenance of all fittings, tubing, piping, elbows, or junctions to ensure there are no leaks or areas of concern.
