Hi Arthur,

We have set up a normal process for obtaining access to sample potential water sources that includes mailing an access request letter to the owner's address on file and allowing 30 days for a response. If we get no response after 30 days or if the letter comes back to us "Return To Sender" then we exclude the source from the Available Water Source list.

Below is the information on the Verkerk well. We sent an access request letter to the address **2808 North Ave Suite 440, Grand Junction, CO 81501** on 7/3/13 and it came back "Return to Sender" on 7/11/13 (see Status Report). We were unable to obtain permission to sample the well.
