This exception location request is being submitted on behalf of Tabula Rasa Energy, LLC (Tabula Rasa). Per the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission Order 520-1 the Entrada and Dakota formations were declared a common source and instituted a 160 acre spacing of all of Section 4 in T29S R69W.

The proposed Caddell 2 is 630' from the Caddell 1 (API No. 05-055-06285) which is producing from the Dakota. The Entrada formation has been abandoned. Tabula Rasa respectfully requests approval to drill the Caddell 2 on the existing well pad of the Caddell 1 and produce exclusively from the Entrada formation. Currently, there is no production in the Entrada formation within this allowed 160 acre spacing. For Tabula Rasa's purposes they intend to only explore and produce from the Entrada, as the gas produced from the Dakota is not optimal for their business purposes.
