Access: Use existing access
 Drilling: Efficiency Rig
 Cuttings: Cuttings will be stored on the north side of the pad with excess going to the PA 44-27 pad. Once drilling and completions are done, the cuttings will be hauled back from the PA 44-27 pad to be used in the reclamation of the PA 543-27 pad.
 SIMOPS: No
 Completions: Completions will either frac on pad or remote frac from the PA 11-35 frac pad (Puckett surface) and 3-4.5" surface frac lines will be run from frac pad to PA 543-27 pad. A water supply line will be run from the PA 11-35 frac pad along existing roads/pipeline corridors to a tie-in near the main road.
 Flowback: To PA 11-35 Frac Pad
 Production: Production equipment to be placed on the east end of the pad. Condensate and water will be piped to the proposed East Parachute Tank Farm (Exxon surface).
 Pipeline: New 8" gas/4" produced water line/2-2" condensate lines are needed.
