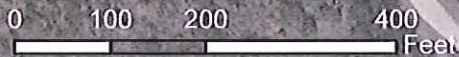
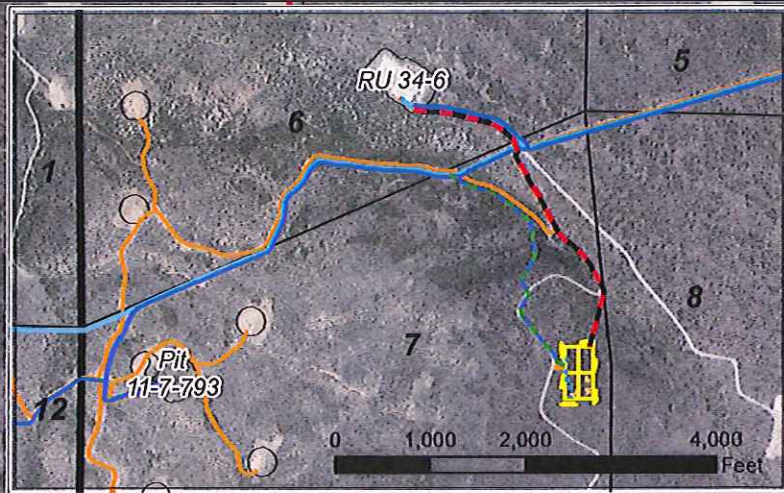

 Cuttings: Cuttings will be managed on surface.  
 SIMOPS: Yes  
 Completions: Completions will frac from the RU 34-6 pad. 3-4.5" surface frac lines will run from the RU 42-7 pad to the RU 34-6 pad. Water will be stored in the RU 11-7 frac pit. Water supply lines already exist.  
 Flowback: From RU 34-6  
 Production: Production equipment to be place on the southwest edge of the pad.  
 Pipeline: A new 8" buried gas, 6" buried water line & 6" buried completions water line will be installed from the pad to the tie-in in the main road.
