Berry has COGCC concurrence to vent the subject well for a 90-day period. Please see the Conditions Of Approval on the Sundry ("Comments & COAs" tab).

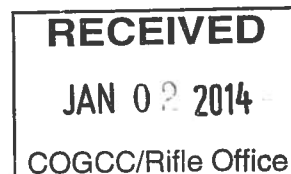

I appreciate your time today discussing the Chevron 11-342, as discussed we have opened the braden head (surface casing) to vent with a starting pressure of 350 psi on 12/31/2013. At this time it appears the 4 1/2" production casing is communicating with the surface casing. The pressure is maintaining 80 psi and is affecting the flow conditions of the well. I agree that shutting in the well at this time is prudent and LINN Energy will establish a remediation plan within 14 days and get back to you.
