Dear Lainie:

As we have discussed, Coleman Oil and Gas is proposing to drill a new Fruitland Coal well in the N/2 of Sec. 16, T33N-R7W. Since this is the first well in the unit, it will be drilled under COGCC Spacing Order 112-60 (amended by 112-61). Coleman is also proposing to drill a second horizontal well, utilizing this same wellbore, or from the same pad. This well will be drilled under COGCC Spacing Order 112-157. Both of these orders require that the production zone be at least 990 feet from the exterior lines of the spacing unit.

The landowner is requesting that the well be located 600 feet from the East section line. Coleman Oil & Gas is proposing to directionally drill both wells so that the wells will enter the coal at least 750' from the East section line. In order to do this, Coleman will need a waiver of the 990' setback requirements under COGCC Orders 112-60 (amended by 112-61) and 112-157.

Coleman Oil and Gas is also currently going thru the hearing process to allow for 80 acre in-fills for this unit. It was not included in previous orders. The order should mirror the other 80 acre in-fill orders that have been issued for the Fruitland Coal in La Plata County.


