


Geologist Information

Plan of Development
 Access: Will use existing access
 Drilling: Efficiency rig
 Cuttings: Cutting to be managed on surface.
 SIMOPS: No
 Completion: Run a 10" temporary surface water line on the east side of CR 215 in the CR 215 right-of-way as shown to get to the pad.
 Frac crew and frac tanks will sit on pad and complete wells after rig leaves. Water and condensate will be kept on pad.
 Flowback: On pad.
 Prod Equip: Production equipment to be set on the east side of the pad and tank to be set on the south end of pad.
 Pipeline: No new line will be needed.
