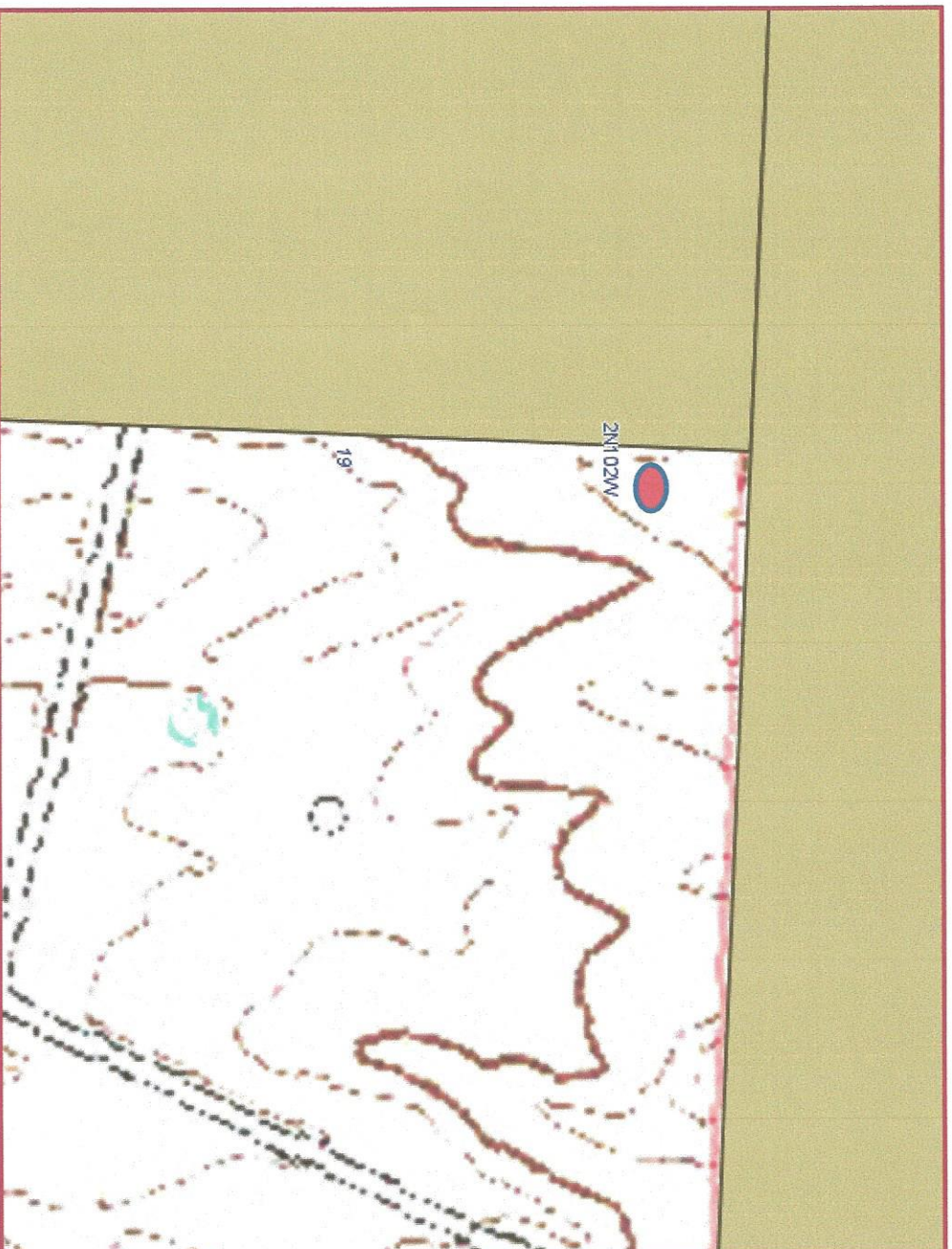

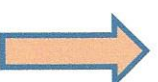
WELL HEAD
