Cause of spill (e.g. equipment failure, human error, etc.): Human Error Detailed description of the spill/release incident:

A water truck driver had his truck connected to the a load out bowl and was preparing to pull a load of produced water from one of the produced water tanks. He was unable to pull the load because the load out bowl valve was frozen. He disconnected from the load out bowl and pulled his load through the top hatch. When he completed his transfer he forgot to close the load out bowl valve. When the tank refilled, produced water flowed out of the open valve and out into the impervious plastic lined SPCC containment structure.

CORRECTIVE ACTION

Describe immediate response (how stopped, contained and recovered): When the release was discovered, the open valve was closed. A vac truck was dispatched to the location to vacuum off the free standing liquids in the lined SPCC containment structure. The entire release was contained within the lined SPCC containment structure. No fluids migrated out of the containment or off the facility.

Describe any emergency pits constructed: None were constructed.

How was the extent of contamination determined? By field measurements and mapping with a Trimble GPS unit.

Further remediation activities proposed (attach separate sheet if needed): None are currently planned. The lined SPCC containment structure performed as it was designed and captured all of the fluids from the release allowing for 100 percent recovery.

Describe measures taken to prevent problem from reoccurring: The driver responsible for the release was retrained in the entire process of loading and unloading water and the precautions that need to be taken to prevent any spills.

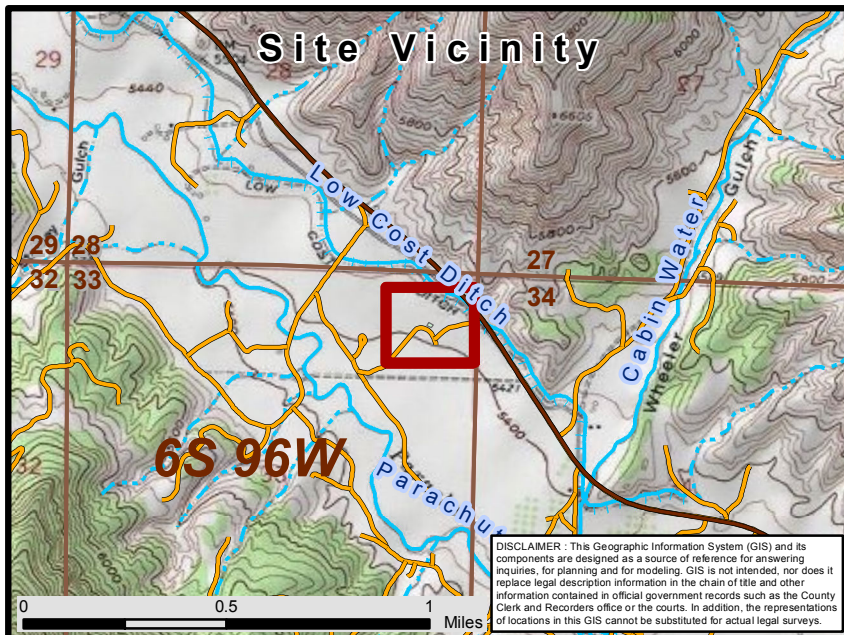
