Detailed description of the spill/release incident:

On February 08, 2014 at 23:45, a water hauler hauling fresh water to the State North Platte F 26 pad location proceeded to pump fresh water into the wrong tank. This tank was a full flowback tank and the freshwater caused the tank to overtop releasing 2BBLs of flowback water before the release was observed. Approximately 2BBLs of flow-back water were released on to the ground outside of containment.

CORRECTIVE ACTION

Describe immediate response (how stopped, contained and recovered): The water truck pump was stopped and a vac truck was called to clean up the pooled liquid. The majority of the flow-back water had frozen, so equipment was dispatched to excavate the ice and impacted surface soil.

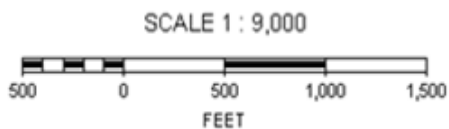
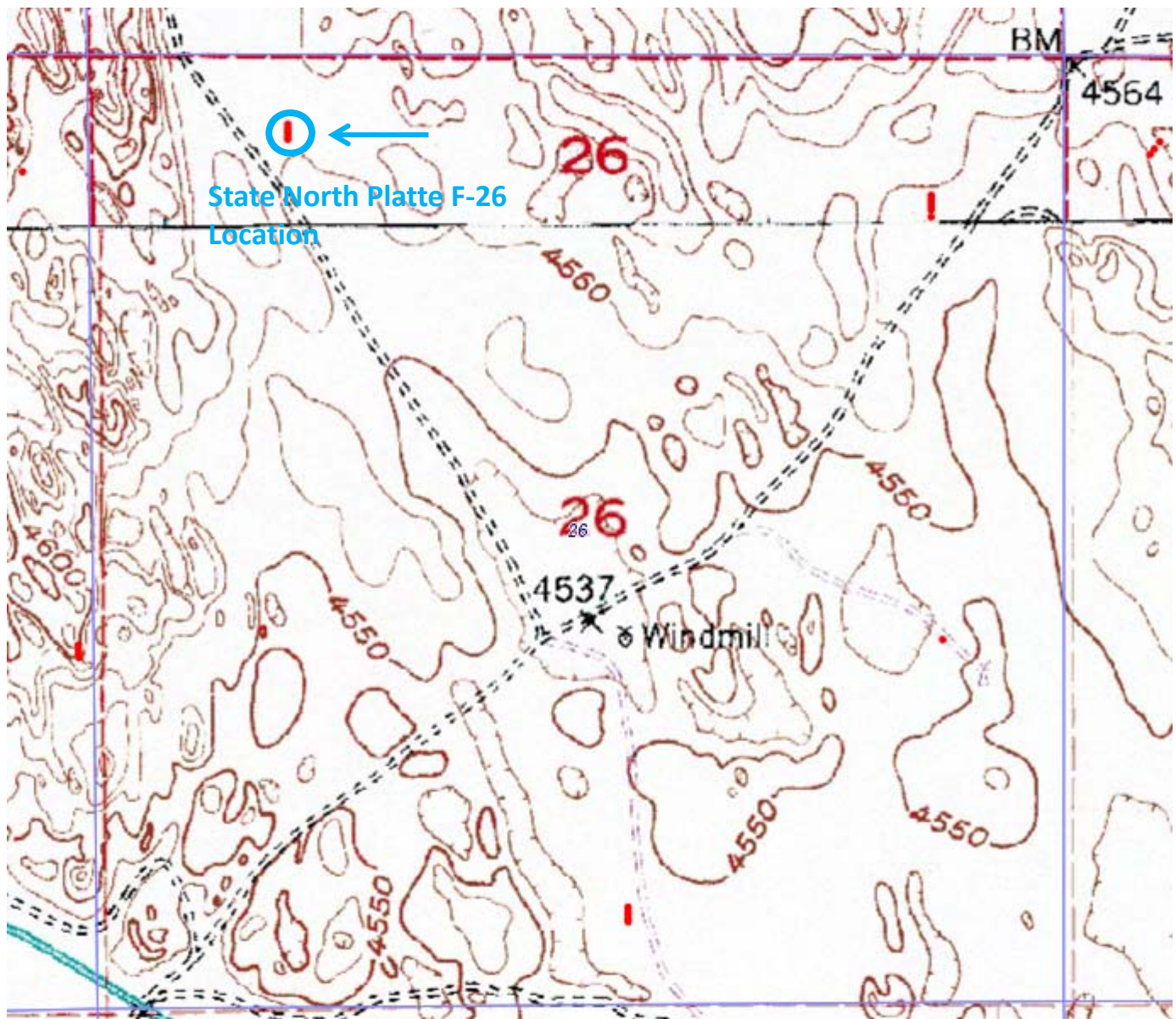
