Alex,

Yes we have. Jeff Hofman with Olsson & Associates and myself met informally with Glenn Hartmann, Sr. Planner for Garfield County on February 6th, and Jeff has also sent e-mails and left phone messages with Glenn and his boss on February 10th and February 13th.

One of the outstanding items from our Technically Incomplete letter pertains to the private roads that lead to our 32C facility (Garden Gulch Road & Garden Gulch Extension Road), and whether they meet the county's standards of Article 7, particularly 7-107 / Access and Roadways. The county was going to do some research from previous projects to see if they could find any information on Garden Gulch Road and Garden Gulch Extension road that could be applied to Marathon's LIR application. We have suggested to Glenn that a possible solution could be for the county to remove the road issue from our LIR application and address it as a separate project since these roads are private roads managed and controlled by a group of operators and not Marathon. On February 6th Glenn had not had time to meet with his boss regarding our application. Marathon and Olsson & Associates are trying to work on options to meet the intent of the Garfield County Land Use Code when it comes to roadway issues, however we can't do anything further until we hear back from the county.

I am hopeful that we will hear something this week. I will keep you posted as to the status of our application.
