A leak occurred on a four inch fiberglass production flow line at Emerald 80X which was shut in for sub-surface maintenance.

CORRECTIVE ACTION

Describe immediate response (how stopped, contained and recovered): The line was shut in immediately upon detection. Vacuum trucks removed all of the free fluid. The fluids that were picked up were taken to the truck unloading facility at the Main Water Plant for recycling. All contaminated soils were taken to the landfarm for remediation.


