As discussed in our January 28, 2014 meeting, Marathon will not meet the March 3, 2014 Form 15 extension deadline for completion of all outstanding Form 28 actions and intends to continue operating the 32C Pond within all other COGCC regulations with COGCC oversight. Marathon proposes to submit to you on a weekly basis an e-mail that provides the status of pending actions and a timeline for working through the Garfield County Limited Impact Review process. This week's actions are as follows:

Status of COGCC Facility ID #433736 - (February 22-28)

1) Garfield County Limited Impact Review – On Monday, February 24, Olsson & Associates sent an e-mail on behalf of Marathon to Garfield County requesting that resolution of road issues related to Garden Gulch Road and Garden Gulch Extension Road be managed separate from the 32C LIR. As of Friday, February 28, Marathon has not received a response from Garfield County to the request.

2) There were no environmental or safety events (incidents, near misses or good catches) this week at the facility.
