Hi All,

This is Taylor Elm, Land Use Specialist with Colorado Parks and Wildlife. I am in the process of reviewing the Form 2A state permit for the SWEPI - North Hayden 1-26 well pad located on the Jimmy Dunn Gulch State Trust Lands.

On July 19, 2013 an onsite of this location was conducted where best management practices to mitigate impacts to wildlife were discussed. These BMPs have been incorporated by Shell on their submitted Form 2A, although there were two additional measures that CPW would like to see included for this location:

1. Shell will coordinate with State Land Board and gate (as agreed upon) the well pad access road from Routt County Road 80 to prevent public access.
2. Shell will use exclusionary (wildlife and livestock) fencing to protect reclaimed areas until vegetation is established.

If you could let me know if everyone is in concurrence on these additional BMPs, or if we need to talk them over further, that would be appreciated. CPW's deadline for comment on this permit is Feb. 12, 2014.
