Jake,

The COGCC definition for a Reference Area is within the 100 series of our Rules. Please review our definition of Reference Area. The Reference Area Map is a topo map showing the proposed oil and gas location **AND** the location of your chosen Reference Area. Reference Area Pictures are four color photographs of the Reference Area, taken during the growing season of vegetation and facing each cardinal direction. Each photo shall be identified by the date taken, well or Oil and Gas Location name, and direction of view. The Reference Area photos may be submitted at any time up to 12 months after the Form 2A. The two attachments you included do not satisfy the requirement for a Reference Area Map and Reference Area Photos as they only show your proposed Oil and Gas Location.

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
