Ladies/Gentlemen:

Kerr-McGee Oil & Gas Onshore LP (“KMG”) respectfully requests the Director to approve an exception to Rule 317.o and only run an LWD gamma ray log in the horizontal section in the above stated wells on the same well pad. Rule 317.o of the Colorado Oil and Gas Commission's Rules and Regulations requires wells to be logged with a minimum of a resistivity log with gamma-ray. The above-named wells are requested to be exempt from this requirement due to the proximity of existing well(s) with acceptable resistivity logs with gamma ray. The available log(s) are within 660 feet of the vertical section of the above stated wells.

The proposed wells will be logged with an LWD gamma ray log in the horizontal section. The wells will also be cased-hole logged with a cement bond log from the production casing shoe to the surface.

The existing well(s) between 660 feet and 1000 feet away with acceptable resistivity logs with gamma ray are listed in the table below:
