Kiki,

We agree to these conditions:

1. Drilling will occur outside the seasonal timing recommendation for BHS winter range (Nov. 1 to April 15)
2. Drilling on these two sites will occur on, or very near, previously disturbed ground (existing well pads or industrial sites).
3. CPW's assessment of the proposed well locations is that they can be drilled during elk production avoidance period (May 15 to June 30) without greatly disturbing known population groups of elk.

I am copying Mr. Greg Deranleau, of the COGCC with this email. It establishes a record of our consultation prior to filing the Form 2A for new well pads.

We're asking to drill between the time frame of May 15 thru September 15, due to the bad weather that usually occurs after mid September.

Good morning Kiki;

Thank you for your patience as CPW reviews your request and our information at these two sites.

Here are our initial comments:

Well site #1 @ Section 15 T27S R70W - This section has been previously impacted by the Little Sheep Mountain CO2 drilling in the 70-80's. CPW has mapped parts of Section 15 as Bighorn sheep winter range and elk production. Individually, each map covers a portion of Section 15; collectively, both maps cover the entire Section. Bighorn sheep are often seen by employees at the ARCO site and elk calving is known to occur within the lower reaches where water is available during the spring months.

Recommendation: CPW recommends that drilling occur within, or near (perhaps less than 600') previously disturbed areas AND a seasonal timing avoidance restriction for both species

- Nov. 1 to April 15 for BHS winter range
- May 15 to June 30 for Elk Production

Well site #2 @ Section 12 T27S R70W - The coverage for this section indicates Elk Production.

Recommendation: CPW recommends a similar seasonal timing avoidance for the period May 1 to June 30. Again, if new well drilling could occur within, or near, previously disturbed sites CPW would do an onsite with the company to discuss exemptions to our recommendations..
