Kris,

This where we're at with the Kaline spill cleanup.

We have a bermed and lined storage facility on location.

The spill area has straw waddles and oil booms installed to prevent any weather created runoff from spreading beyond the initial contaminated area.

We have cleaned up some of the contaminated soils but weather and thawing ground conditions have

hampered our efforts greatly.

The conditions are being monitored almost daily so that we can move in and clean up as much as possible when the weather allows it.

The site has been visited 3 time per week since the spill occurred.
