There was deviation in the testing of the samples from approved work plan, doc number 2147328.

Per original form 27, "Samples will be collected <5 ft. bgs for P-8 and analyzed for the Table 910-1 organics (dro, and gro) w/BTEX, Inorganics (EC, SAR, pH), and metals. Samples will be collected at PID hits and at the bottom

of the boring for the other locations."

Per submitted report, no GRO's were sampled, a TPH # was generated and apparently based on the DRO (C10-C28).

3 samples (out of 26 total samples) were analyzed for full 910-1. No Prior authorization was give to limit 910-1 analysis.

Any future deviation of the approved work plan must have prior approval by the COGCC.

2 areas were identified as impacted by production operations, no reclamation was suggested on report. A Form 27, remediation work plan should be submitted for remediation of these 2 areas with a timeline for remediation work to be completed.
